



ND ACDA HS/Collegiate SSAA Honor Choir
February 3-4, 2023

The ND ACDA HS/Collegiate SSAA Honor Choir, consisting of treble voices from eleventh grade through college, will take place February 3rd and 4th. Registration begins at noon on Friday and the choir will rehearse for two days. The HS/Collegiate SSAA choir will be featured on the North Dakota ACDA Conference Concert on Saturday, February 4th in the afternoon and they will perform at Friday night's Showcase Concert. Students must be in attendance at all rehearsals and performances to participate in the honor choir event. All participating teachers must be members of ACDA.

Registration is due November 4, 2022. Registration is online via google form.

Directors may select up to six singers:

- A single student for any section (S1, S2, A)
- Two students (one soprano, one alto)
- Three students (one soprano 1, one soprano 2, one alto)
- An additional trio may be selected according to the same principles above (please fill the entire first trio before adding students to a second trio in order to achieve a balanced ensemble)

Fees are due December 2, 2022. The registration fees are \$45 for high school and collegiate singers. A fee of \$50 will be assessed for late registrations.

**The registration fee covers the costs of music, Friday evening meal, Saturday noon meal and a t-shirt.*

The honor choir will be held at the ND ACDA Convention site. Students/schools are responsible for student transportation and lodging. All high school students must be chaperoned by a teacher or parent.

Performance attire for the Friday night Showcase Concert is the NDACDA t-shirt and jeans. Performance attire for the Saturday night's concert is the participant's school/college choral uniform (formal or robe). If a participant's school does not utilize a uniform, an **ALL BLACK** dress or pants outfit, which is at least knee-length may be worn.
